



**Women's Giving Circle of Harford County
2021 Grant Awards
Total Awarded = \$43,515.56**

Boys and Girls Clubs - \$5,000

Supports "Club on the Go", a new initiative that will bring youth development programming and food access to under-resourced families in the high-need Edgewood and Aberdeen areas.

Edgewood Community Support Center - \$5,000

Provides partial support for a case manager's salary to continue to connect women facing challenges due to financial, physical, and/or mental health issues with resources in the community.

Faith Communities and Civic Agencies United, Inc. - \$1,800

Provides funding for six Chrome Books and software to be used by the women in their program. The Chrome Books will provide the opportunity for the women to acquire an email account, complete interest and skill assessments, and job search.

Found in Faith Ministries - \$2,737.16

Supports the Sweet Dreams: Fresh Start Furniture Program with the purchase of new mattress covers and pillows.

Harford County Education Foundation - \$4,978.40

Supports the Foundation's partnership with Harford County Public Schools to form "Littles University." HCPS will release a video reading of an age-appropriate book for parents and children to view and participate on a monthly basis. The featured book will be mailed by the Foundation to 250 children (ages birth to 5 years) each month.

Harford Family House - \$3,000

Supports transportation for single mothers with children to get to and from work, to take their children to and from daycare, after-school activities, doctor appointments, and any other trips needed via a bus pass, cab fare, and ride share.

Homecoming Project - \$2,500

Supports ongoing shelter operations and updating household and yard accessories that have become worn/broken over the years. A shed used by residents to store equipment used for yard upkeep will be repaired by a program graduate.

HUMANIM, Inc. - \$5,000

Supports the Administrative Assistant Career Training Program, a nine-week training session for participants to earn two certifications: Microsoft Office Specialist and Professional Administrative

Certificate of Excellence. Instruction includes emerging trends in remote-working, advanced professional “soft skills” development, wraparound and financial stability supports, and a two-week administrative project assimilation.

Lions Association - \$3,500

Provides funding for hearing aids for low-income women in Harford County.

The Sexual Assault Spouse Abuse Resource Center Inc. (SARC) - \$5,000

Provides assistance with childcare and ride share transportation via for 100 program participants.
