Members' Choice Award

Nominate a Nonprofit for our 3rd Members' Choice Award!

On November 29, 2022, the Women's Giving Circle of Harford County will gather at the Maryland Golf and Country Club for our holiday happy hour and Giving Tuesday celebration! At this celebration, we will present the third Members' Choice Award to a deserving nonprofit, selected by you, the local philanthropists who have helped WGC reach this milestone.

When they established the Women's Giving Circle in 2011, our founding members pledged to set aside 25% of each yearly contribution in an endowment fund. This fund empowers our members' contributions to grow far into the future.

They also agreed that, once the fund reached \$100,000, up to 5% could be used to supplement WGC's ongoing annual grant fund or to create a separate award. Now, the endowment fund has grown to more than

\$142,000 and allows us to award the third Members' Choice Award in the amount of \$5,517.28.

The time to select our second Members' Choice Award recipient is now! A member may nominate any 501(c) (3) organization that serves women and children in Harford County and that has total expenses that do not exceed \$1 million.
